To be eligible to apply, applicants must meet all the requirements below.

Criteria	Eligibility
Nationality	<p>Non-Korean: Applicants and their parents must be nationals of a country other than Korea.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Applicants and their parents should obtain foreign nationality before the applicants enter high school. - If applicants and their parents have dual citizenship, they should both renounce their Korean citizenship before the applicants start high school.
Education	<p>Applicants who have completed or are expected to complete the education course corresponding to that of high school in Korea</p>
International & Applicants under an agreement	<p>Applicants who meet at least one of the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. TOPIK Level 3 or above B. Kyungwoon TOPIK Level 3 or above C. (Expected) Completion of Level 4 or above of the KKLI(Kyungwoon Korean Language Institute) regular program D. English proficiency test scores: TOEFL(PBT 500, CBT 175, IBT 61), IELTS 5.5, TOEIC 630, PTE ACADEMIC 43 or above E. Completion of high school education conducted entirely in English F. Recommendation from the head of a higher education institution under an agreement with Kyungwoon University <p>* Korean proficiency requirements can be eased for entrusted students recommended by the Ministry of Education, exchange students, KGSP (Korean Government Scholarship Program) students, Foreign Government Scholarship students, etc.</p>

※ High school graduate equivalency test for self-study, home schooling, or cyber learning will NOT be acknowledged for applications.

※ If the contents of the documents differ following the academic background check, admission may be revoked even after enrollment.
